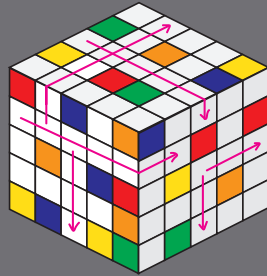


the cruciverbalist
